Tennis Talk

Te have resumed testing on the hydrogrid system at Skyview that keeps our courts evenly hydrated day and night. We started this process last summer when we noticed water consumption rising at an alarming rate. Testing was suspended in the fall when water usage generally falls and our snowbird members return to fill the courts. With court usage down again we are back on the job in coordination with Welch Tennis who built this facility nearly 20 years ago.

We are also searching for answers to unusually long drainage times on court four. All courts puddle when it rains but they normally drain in 2-3 hours. Court four takes much longer to become playable. The south side of that court has sunk about ¾ of an inch creating an unusually large puddle after rain. That is not enough to notice when courts are

dry and do not affect play. Still, we need to get some answers to this



phenomenon before repairs can be affected. As always, we try to make these extensive repairs during slow summer months as courts are often out of commission until the work is done.

We will do our best to block out courts under repair before they are reserved for play. However, we will do what is necessary to get them restored to the highest standard in short order. We ask in advance that you pardon our dust during the process and trust you will be pleased with the results. Citrus Hills' management is committed to keeping Skyview Tennis Center functioning beautifully and looking great!







10 Tips to Beat the Florida Heat

The hottest months of the year are upon us and it's easy to experience the negative effects of too much sun and heat exposure. Here's how to stay cool this summer and beat the Florida heat.

- 1. Stay indoors and in air-conditioned areas as much as possible. Lower your risk of heat stroke by spending at least two hours in an air-conditioned space.
- **2.** Wear light, natural fabrics and loose-fitting clothing. Darker clothes absorb more light. Choose cotton or linen, and white or light colors.
- **3.** Avoid using the oven; use a slow cooker or grill outside. Heat-producing appliances should be averted in favor of low or no-heat alternatives.
- **4. Carefully hydrate.** Dehydration is a serious threat to your health, especially in Florida. Bring along a large water bottle everywhere you go, even if it's just for a couple hours. Drink plenty of fluids and avoid long periods without having a drink like water, unsweet tea or a sports drink to replenish electrolytes. Store a couple gallons of water in your vehicle in the event of a breakdown too.
- **5. Protect yourself from the sun.** When outdoors, make it a point to be in the shade whenever possible to avoid heat stroke. Wear a wide-brimmed hat and sunglasses. Apply a high SPF sunscreen before venturing outside.
- **6. Keep cool, refreshing products on-hand.** Stock up and keep aloe vera, frozen water bottles, ice, popsicles, and other cooling items ready for use through the summer months.
- 7. Eat more fruits and vegetables. Increasing your intake of fruits and vegetables will help keep you hydrated. They are also easier to digest.
- **8.** Avoid peak sun hours. Alter your schedule to remain indoors during the hottest hours of the day. Venture outdoors during the early morning or late evening. Plan indoor activities mid-day.
- **9.** Leave pets at home. Don't leave pets unattended in a closed, parked vehicle. Opt to leave them at home or with a pet sitter. Inside vehicle temperatures can quickly lead to heatstroke and death for beloved pets.
- 10. Know your limits. Be conscious of the heat and don't overdo it. It is easy to experience the dangerous consequences of too much sun/heat in Florida. Keep track of time spent outdoors and monitor your health. If you notice heat illness symptoms, rest, hydrate and call for assistance if needed.
