Are you having trouble deciding on which aerobic classes are best for you? Sometimes this can be overwhelming for some exercisers, especially new members to the Club. If so, I can provide some advice to help you decide which classes are best for you.

Observing the class first, before you participate, is a very good way to see the intensity level and pace. Ask the instructor if you can quietly watch the class from the back of the room.
