












## BellaVita Fitness & Spa By Lee Thompson, Director of Spa & Fitness

re you having trouble deciding On which aerobic classes are best for you? Sometimes this can be overwhelming for some exercisers, especially new members to the Club. If so, I can provide some advice to help you decide which classes are best for

Observing the class first, before you participate, is a very good way to see the intensity level and pace. Ask the instructor if you can quietly watch the class from the back of the room. I also recommend that you talk to some of the members or even the instructor once the class has finished. Talking to the instructor will let you know what the overall class goals are: toning, weight loss, flexibility, or cardio. Some parts of the class may be more intense than others.

Determine your preferred impact level. Aerobic classes are usually divided into low, medium, and high impact. If you haven't exercised in a while and get out of breath easily, be sure to start out with a class at a slower pace and move up over time. Find the activity level of a class that best accommodates your comfort level. We have 45 classes per week that offer something for every member no matter what level of fitness you are. Some classes are appropriate for all levels of fitness. Our class schedules

also list instructors teaching and a description of the class on the back of the schedules. Get familiar with those class descriptions,



they will help you to decide which classes are best for you.

Two classes I would like to highlight are Spinning and Pilates. If you already enjoy working out on a stationary bike or your own bike at home, then a spin class can be even more fun. Spinning is a great low-impact workout that not only incorporates a way to burn calories but also can be a high-energy cardiovascular exercise. Working out along with others can also help with motivating you — the energy in the room is contagious. Pilates is another low-impact workout that is good for all ages and abilities and is effective at strengthening, lengthening, and toning your muscles through controlled, repetitive movements. The benefits of Pilates are endless: whole body and mind fitness strengthens muscles, increases flexibility, develops core strength, improves posture, increases energy, and supports a healthy weight.


