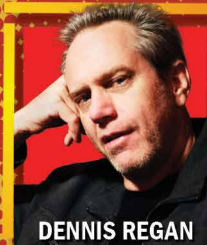

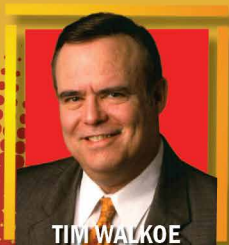

The pre-treatment questionnaire is one of the most important tools for delivering a successful spa service. Some questions may seem too personal or unimportant to the member, but they are critical to the technician. Our therapists think of themselves as healers and are very nurturing. We like to build relationships with our guests, and intake forms are an essential start. Often the client can be a complete stranger; the more information a therapist or technician learns ahead of the service, the better the experience and results. These questionnaires should be updated yearly. First-timer clients must arrive at least 15-20 minutes before their service to fill out intake forms.

Examples of questions: Are you taking Retin-A or Accutane? Do you have any allergies? Are you pregnant?

Our guests put themselves in our hands, so we pride ourselves on making the experience positive and memorable. Here are four examples of why those questions and checkmark boxes are on the questionnaire.

1. It reveals potential medical constraints. Hot stones can be a problem with diabetics. High-frequency facial machines can trigger an asthma attack. Chemo patients should avoid deep tissue massages.

2. It starts a dialogue with your technician by completing the questions

ahead of time; the therapists or estheticians will have the information they need to best customize your experience and make the most of your appointment.

3. It opens the door to new healing modalities. Products are often adjusted and customized according to the intake information. Therapists know to remove algae for clients with seafood allergies, or lavender can lessen depression.

4. It keeps your relationship with the therapist relaxed and comfortable. Spa treatments can be a very intimate experience, and the technician wants to ensure you feel extremely comfortable before they begin. It is standard procedure to review the questionnaire with the client before their first treatment or session and to cover additional issues that may not be addressed on the form, such as; body aches, areas to avoid, etc.

A good therapist never relies just on the intake form for their information; they should set aside plenty of time before the initial treatment to talk through your answers and ask you about your health needs and what you want from your session. A client intake form is there to help you and your therapist, so fill it in as comprehensively as you can.

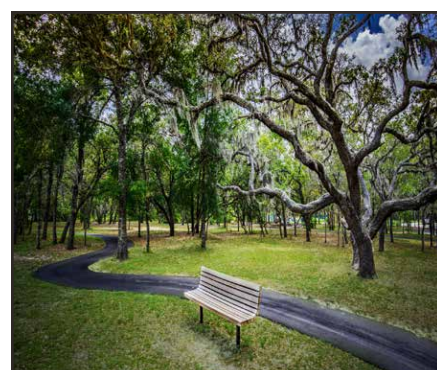
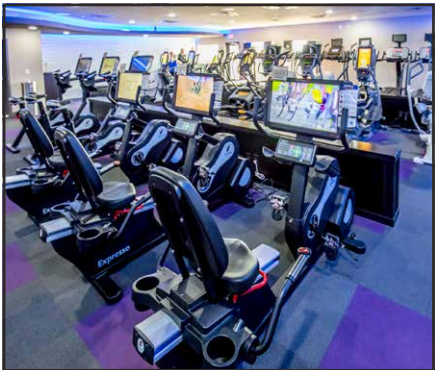
