
park, platform tennis courts, bocce ball, sand volleyball, beach tennis, croquet courts, corn toss, walking paths, and a new children's playground.

10 Spring Cleaning & Maintenance Tips for the Home

- 1. Do an outdoor home inspection and check for any damage. Check out gutters and downspouts, sprinklers, AC units, outdoor faucets, and cracks in driveways, walkways, and pool decks.
- 2. Take inventory of your lawn and landscape. Trim dead pieces and overgrowth. Look at all trees and shrubs and cut them back if they touch your home, fence, or other structures. Remove old, weak, or diseased limbs that could fall in the event of high winds. Seed bare and thin spots of the lawn. Add new plants for a spring spruce-up.
- 3. Inspect caulking around the home. Check all access points to your house, like doors and windows, for small gaps. If you see any spaces, have them filled. The smallest spaces can let bugs in.
- 4. Pressure wash the outside of your home. Hire a trusted professional, or do it yourself! Removing all the mold and mildew build-up from the rainy season will make a massive difference in your home's appearance.
- 5. Clean your gutters and downspouts. If your gutters get clogged, they can cause water to seep down between the interior and exterior walls of your home and cause damage. Clean out all debris, check for leaks, and seal your gutters.
- **6.** Have your roof inspected. If your roof hasn't been inspected lately, have a professional walk the roof and make a note of the wear and any damage. Get a clear picture of the state of your roof before the next hurricane season begins.
- 7. Review fire safety items. Check fire extinguishers and smoke detector batteries. Inspect plugs for signs of discoloration, softened plastic, and scorch marks. Replace when needed and call an electrician for signs of electrical damage.
