Recently, some members asked what the difference is between Bill Pay and ACH payments related to dues. Bill Pay is when you request the bank to pay your bill for you and generate a physical paper check, and then they mail it out to us. The problem for most members is that the USPS is slow in delivery resulting in payments arriving after the due date. ACH payments are debits that the Club requests from your bank the business day before the payment is due. The ACH payment program is the most secure and reliable way to guarantee that your dues payments arrive on time to the Club. If you want to sign up for ACH debits, all we need is a voided check and some basic paperwork filled out giving your consent. You can stop by

the Accounting Office located at the Activity Center, and someone will be happy to assist you. Also, be on the lookout for an email with a link that will take you directly to the ACH form if you would like to print it from home and then get it back to us. We encourage anyone not signed up for the ACH payments program to take advantage of this convenient and automated way to pay your Club dues.

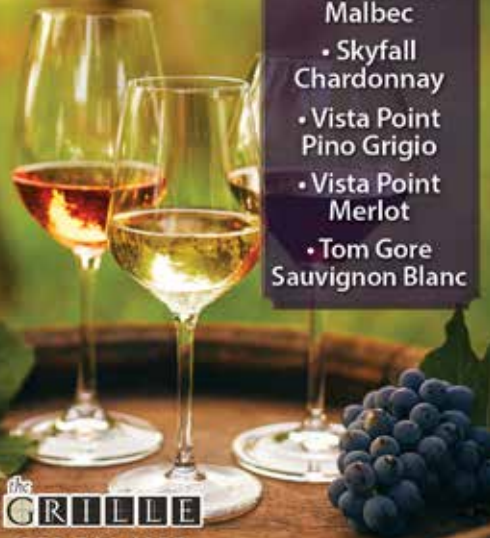

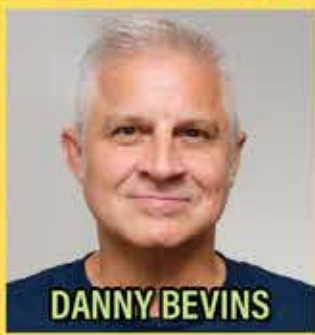

## 10 Tips For Keeping Safe Online

- 1. Ensure you have adequate antivirus protection.** Install a good antivirus program on your computer and mobile device to protect yourself from malicious threats online. Norton and McAfee are great options.
- 2. Don't click on pop-ups or suspicious-looking links.** Whether it's an ad or a link from a text, email, or Facebook, it's not worth the risk of infecting your device or compromising your personal information. Delete the message and close the pop-up.
- 3. Use a password manager.** One of the most effective things you can do to be safe online is to secure your accounts with a strong, variety of unique, and complex passwords. You can create good passwords with a password generator and also keep track of your passwords with a password manager like 1Password.
- 4. Do not accept friend requests from people you do not know,** or people you are already friends with. If you receive a strange message from a friend requesting that you send money, to click on an untrustworthy link, or other suspicious requests, delete the message and contact your friend immediately via a different communication method (phone call, email, or text).
- 5. Always check the email address and not just the sender's name.** When this happens, the sender's name may be familiar, but the email address doesn't match the sender's name. For example, the email may say "Walmart.com" but the email address is "njqq9.22yzrrkif8jahx8@2djfi9yc29rg.us". If the email was actually from Walmart, the email address would be from "@walmart.com".
- 6. Keep your system updated.** Make sure to stay on top of update notifications from your computer or mobile device. They are critical in patching up new security vulnerabilities and keeping you safe from hackers. You can set your computer to automatically install updates when they become available.
- 7. Ask yourself clarifying questions.** Ask yourself, "Why would my bank ask me to log on or confirm a payment or USPS/Amazon about a package?" Or, "How did you win a sweepstake that you never entered in the first place?" By asking yourself these types of questions, it will likely expose whether the message is from a legitimate source or not.
- 8. Look for typos.** Phishing attacks frequently use similar spellings as the brands they are trying to spoof, for example "amazn.com", or "support@micr0soft.com" to fool users. Get a mobile security app like Bitdefender with real-time web protections that can block phishing links before you open them.
- 9. Sign up for an ID theft protection service.** A program like LifeLock is a security tool that identifies when a user's sensitive information is leaked or distributed. Then, a user can take appropriate steps to protect their identity, like freezing their credit, closing associated accounts, and notifying credit bureaus of potential ID theft.
- 10. Don't be afraid to ask for help!** Computer running slowly? Weird email? Incredibly cheap products? Strange notifications? Make sure you have a trusted family member or human to speak with. And some antivirus programs like Norton have a remote access tool, which allows tech support operators to get into your computer and solve problems 24/7.
