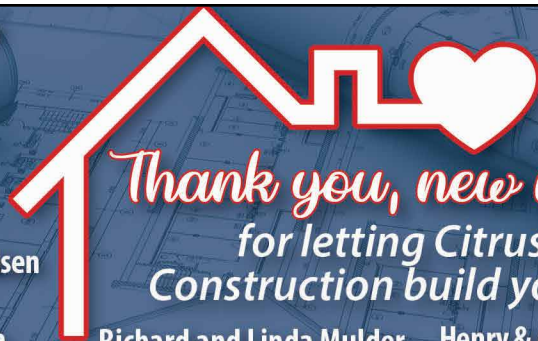

Hello everyone. If you are in Terra Vista, you may have noticed that Duke Energy has replaced certain street light fixtures along Terra Vista Boulevard. Duke is still working on updating the fixtures at the front entrance and along Fenway Drive. If you are in Belmont Hills, you will notice that Duke has already started, and the installation is still in progress. Brentwood Farms residents will notice Duke updating the community fixtures sometime in August. Stay tuned.

By now, our residents in Terra Vista, Belmont Hills, and Brentwood Farms have received a Spectrum bulk internet and cable update. In case you missed it or did not receive the letter, your services have increased dramatically. The new bulk internet and cable contract includes the following:

1. Three (3) digital/HD boxes (up from 2), with 1 being a DVR with DVR service and optional Cloud DVR service;
2. Spectrum Select with

Entertainment View and Sports View

3. Access to On-Demand choices; and

4. Spectrum Advance Community WiFi – 500 Mbps download speed, 20 Mbps upload speed internet service (up from 200 x 10), along with a modem and wireless router.

It is possible that some of you will need new equipment to handle the increase in internet speed.
