

Oaks & Meadows: Todd's Tips

By Todd Bleidner, PGA, Head Golf Professional

Finding the optimal distance from the golf ball is a key factor in establishing a solid and repeatable swing. To determine the correct distance, follow these steps for a consistent setup:

1. **Club Length Reference:** Begin by positioning the clubhead behind the ball while maintaining a straight posture. Let your arms hang naturally so your hands are directly below your shoulders. This distance will provide a starting point for your setup.

2. **Bend at the Hips:** Flex your hips slightly, allowing your upper body to tilt forward from the hips. Keep your spine straight, and bend your knees slightly for balance. This posture promotes a dynamic athletic stance and encourages a more natural swing plane.

3. **Hands Position:** As you bend from the hips, your hands should naturally fall just ahead of your belt buckle or mid-thigh area. This hand position ensures you have enough room to swing the club while maintaining control and power.

4. Flex Your Arms:

Your arms should hang naturally, with a slight bend at the elbows.

The distance between your body and the clubhead should enable your arms to move freely in the backswing and downswing.

5. **Feel Comfortable:** The correct distance will allow you to comfortably reach the ball with a slight bend in your arms while maintaining your balance and athletic posture.

Remember, personal factors such as height, arm length, and swing style can influence your setup. Experiment with different distances during practice to find the one that feels most comfortable and promotes consistent ball striking. Regularly reviewing and adjusting your setup will lead to improved swing mechanics and enhanced performance on the course.





Ten Secrets For Surviving Airline Travel

- 1. If you can, travel early in the day.** Delays can be hard to avoid in the busy travel months, but traveling first thing in the morning is your best bet for avoiding the ripple effect of a day of cancellations and delays. Of course, you could still be unlucky and face the aftershocks of the day before. But generally speaking, the airport and airline system resets itself overnight.
- 2. Book off-peak travel days.** Most passengers want to travel on peak days – Friday evening, for example, or Monday morning. If you can go on Tuesday, you're less likely to encounter as many people or problems.
- 3. Leave buffer time.** If you can make it work, go a day early. If you can, leaving a day buffer between your flight's arrival and the big event – whether that's a wedding, for example, or a cruise departure – will ensure delayed flights don't wreak havoc on your plans.
- 4. Avoid tight connections.** You always see people running from plane to plane through terminals. Avoid being one of these people that give themselves a minimum window of connecting time.
- 5. Easily track flights and share flight information.** If you use an iPhone or iPad, you can text yourself or others your flight number. Tap the flight number link and select 'Preview Flight.' The flight details will appear with arrival/departure times, status, and an interactive map. Knowing whether your flight is on-time or delayed helps keep things much more organized. If you aren't using an iPhone, you can download an app called FlightAware.
- 6. Arrive at the gate early.** Usually, boarding starts 30 minutes prior. And most of the time, they want to close that door within 10 to 15 minutes before departure. And once the doors are closed, that's it. Wait near your gate; that prevents you from running across the airport. But also watch for any gate changes in the lead-up to boarding.
- 7. If your flight is canceled or delayed, avoid the customer service line.** When things go wrong, rather than waiting in a line of frustrated passengers, it's worth using your cell phone to search options online or to call the airline helplines.
- 8. Pack snacks.** Relying on eating breakfast, lunch, or dinner on your flight can lead to disappointment and "hanger." While you hope everything goes smoothly, there's always the chance the flight might take off late or culinary offerings might be minimal.
- 9. Dress for the journey, not the destination.** Save those vacation-ready items for your arrival, and also bring layers you can easily pull on or take off during the flight.
- 10. Consider whether check-in luggage is necessary.** If you can, just do carry-on. Less is definitely more – pack multipurpose things that you can dress up or dress down, and pack shoes that you could pair with multiple different outfits. There are a lot of bags lost or misplaced. If you do check a bag, be sure to slip an Airtag in it. They can be life savers when trying to locate your bag.
