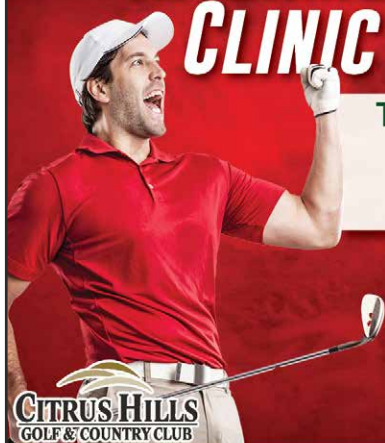

Oaks & Meadows: Todd's Tips

By Todd Bleidner, PGA, Head Golf Professional

The Setup:

Proper setup in golf is crucial for consistency and accuracy in your shots. A solid setup establishes a strong foundation for your swing.

1. Stance: Begin by standing with your feet shoulder-width apart. Your weight should be evenly distributed between both feet, with a slight bias towards the balls of your feet. This balanced stance provides stability and allows for better weight transfer during your swing.

3. Alignment: Proper alignment ensures you're aiming accurately at your target. Pick a spot on your target line, such as a divot or a mark, and align your clubface, hips, and shoulders parallel to it. Your feet should be perpendicular to the target line.

4. Grip: Maintain a neutral grip, where the "V" formed by your thumb and index finger points towards your right shoulder (for right-handed golfers). Grip the club firmly but not too tightly,

as tension can hinder your swing's fluidity.

5. Posture: Bend slightly at the hips, keeping

your back straight and your knees slightly flexed. This athletic posture allows for better rotation during your swing and helps prevent back injuries.

6. Spine Angle: Tilt your spine slightly away from the target for irons and wedges and a bit more for longer clubs like the driver. This promotes a descending blow on the ball with your irons and helps you catch it on the upswing with your driver.

Remember, practice is key to mastering the proper setup. Spend time on the driving range to refine your setup, and it will become second nature, leading to more consistent and accurate shots on the golf course. A solid foundation is the first step to improving your golf game.

With the changing leaves and cooler breezes, we welcome you to another splendid fall season in our beloved community. It's a time of transformation, not only in nature but also within our vibrant neighborhood.

Many of you are aware that a third-party processing company is now charging a \$2 transaction/processing fee if you are signed up for direct debit. This fee was not introduced by the POA, nor does Citrus Hills receive any portion of it. We realize that the imposition of this fee frustrates many of our residents. Therefore, we are actively exploring alternative payment options that will not involve this fee. However, please note that this process is in its early stages, and we do not have an update to share at this time. To provide some "immediate" relief, starting January 1, 2024, we will introduce the option to pay quarterly by direct debit. While this option will include the \$2 transaction fee to the

third-party processor, it will allow most of you to retain the convenience of direct debit while reducing the total annual transaction fees that you pay.

If you have not already done so, please ensure your email contact information is up-to-date with the administration office. This will help us reach you more effectively with important updates. It's important to note that this email database is separate and completely different from the Club's daily emails that you may receive. Being in that database does not ensure you are also in our POA database.

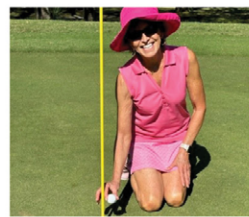

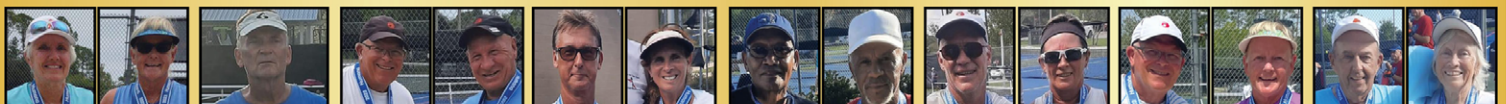

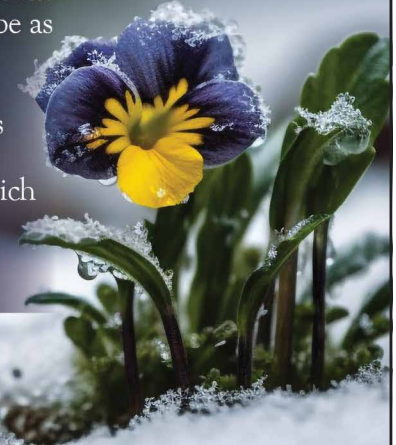
