With all Skyview courts in great shape and LED lights everywhere, don't miss our next tennis social on Sunday, April 7th. Details will be available in the March/April newsletter.















Oaks & Meadows: Todd's Tips

Course management is a critical aspect of golf that often distinguishes amateur players from professionals. While many amateurs focus on improving their swing and technical skills, understanding and implementing effective course management strategies can significantly enhance overall performance on the golf course.

One key tip for you to consider is to prioritize accuracy over distance. While hitting the ball far is enticing, staying in play and avoiding hazards is crucial for consistent scoring. This means choosing the right club for the situation, even if it means sacrificing a few yards for better accuracy. By carefully selecting clubs based on the course layout and conditions, you can avoid unnecessary risks and keep the ball in play.

Another important aspect of course management is knowing when to play aggressively and when to play conservatively. Assessing risk and reward on each hole is essential. For instance, it might be wise to play more conservatively on challenging holes with narrow fairways or

water hazards, aiming for a safer position for the next shot. On the other hand, taking calculated risks on more forgiving holes can lead to



opportunities for lower scores.

Understanding the nuances of the course, such as slopes, bunkers, and green contours, is also crucial. Take the time to go over the course in your head before playing, and develop a game plan for each hole. This includes identifying landing areas, considering pin placements, and adjusting strategies based on the day's weather conditions.

Effective course management improves overall scores and enhances your overall golf experience. It reduces frustration, increases confidence, and helps you enjoy the game by making more informed decisions on the course. Integrating course management into one's golfing strategy is crucial to playing smarter and achieving better results.




