

## GOLF TIPS

Summertime golf in Florida presents its own unique set of challenges, particularly when dealing with the long, thick bermudagrass roughs that flourish during the warmer months. This type of grass grows dense and wiry, often swallowing golf balls and making clean contact difficult. Successfully playing shots from this tough rough requires both strategic decision-making and sound technique.

The first step is proper club selection. Expect the rough to grab the clubhead and reduce clubface control, so choosing a club with more loft — such as a short iron or wedge — increases the chances of escaping cleanly. Avoid long irons or fairway woods unless the lie is especially favorable. When assessing your lie, determine how deep the ball is sitting. If the ball is buried, prioritize

simply getting it back into play.

Adjust your setup by placing the ball slightly farther back in your stance than usual. This encourages a steeper angle of attack, helping you cut through the thick grass before it wraps around the clubface. Grip the club a touch firmer to stabilize the clubhead through impact. On the backswing, limit wrist hinge and focus on a controlled, descending blow. Trying to swing hard usually backfires in thick Bermuda, causing twisted shots or heavy contact.

Finally, manage expectations. Even PGA Tour players struggle from long Florida roughs. Sometimes, the smart play is a simple pitch or punch back to the fairway, giving yourself a better chance to recover and save par. Patience and discipline pay off in the long run.
