





shows, or anything involving table assignments strongly calling the Activity Center if you're coordinating with






Tennis Talk



GOLF TIPS

Helpful Tips for Reading Florida Bermuda Grass Greens

Reading Bermuda grass greens in Florida requires extra awareness, particularly when it comes to understanding grain. Grain refers to the direction in which the grass naturally grows, and it can influence the speed and break of your putts.

On Bermuda greens, grain often follows the path of the sun, leans toward water, or grows in the direction of the slope. You can spot it by noting grass color—lighter or shinier areas usually mean the grain is growing away from you (putts may roll a bit faster), while darker areas suggest the grain is growing toward you (putts may roll a touch slower). Another helpful clue is the grass around the hole; a slightly worn edge typically points

in the direction the grain is arowina.

Walking around your putt and viewing it from multiple angles—especially behind the hole—can give you a clearer sense of break and speed. Feeling the slope with your feet can also help pick up subtle contours.

In the winter months, our greens will be overseeded with ryegrass, which offers a slightly different surface feel. During this time, grain effects may be a bit more subtle, but the overall green performance remains smooth and consistent.

By learning to recognize grain, slope, and seasonal conditions, you'll read our course's greens more confidently and enjoy greater success on the putting surface.






