





While most of us don't think of ourselves as slow players, nearly everyone can find small ways to pick up the pace—and make that keeps everyone

the round more enjoyable for everyone. Playing a little faster doesn't mean rushing; it simply means being ready

and aware.

Start by being prepared when it's your turn. Whether on the tee, in the fairway, or on the green, take time to assess your shot while others are playing so you're ready to go when it's your turn. On the putting green, line up your putt while others are putting, and be ready to move quickly to the next tee once the hole is complete.

Using a cart efficiently can also make a big difference. Drop your partner off at their ball and then drive to yours instead of waiting for each other to hit. If you're

the passenger, grab a few clubs and walk to your ball while the driver plays their shot. It's a small adjustment that keeps everyone moving and helps the round flow more smoothly.

Here's another easy one—be a "one-timer," not a "two-timer." After you hit a shot, don't stop to put your club away before moving on. Keep it with you in the cart as you drive to your next ball. When you arrive, put that club away and pull out your next one in a single motion. It's a simple habit that saves time on every hole—and remember, nobody likes a two-timer!

Remember, slow play doesn't just affect your group. It impacts everyone on the course. A few small adjustments help everyone enjoy a smoother, more enjoyable round. Faster play means happier golfers!
