Golf Tips:

Course management is a key component of golf that often separates amateur players from more experienced ones. While improving swing mechanics is important, learning how to manage the course effectively can have an even greater impact on overall performance.

One of the most important principles of course management is prioritizing accuracy over distance. While long drives are appealing, keeping the ball in play and avoiding hazards leads to more consistent scoring. Choosing the right club for each situation—even if it means giving up a few yards—can reduce risk and help set up better approach shots.

Pesto Chicken Bake with Roasted Red Peppers, Spinach & Burrata

Ingredients

4 boneless, skinless chicken breasts
1/2 teaspoon salt
1/2 teaspoon black pepper
1 tablespoon olive oil
1 cup basil pesto
1 cup roasted red peppers, sliced
2 cups fresh spinach leaves
8 ounces burrata cheese
1/2 cup shredded mozzarella cheese
1/4 cup grated Parmesan cheese
1 teaspoon Italian seasoning
Fresh basil leaves for garnish

Directions

Preheat oven to 375°F.
Season both sides of the chicken breasts with salt, black pepper, and Italian seasoning.
Heat olive oil in a skillet over medium-high heat. Sear chicken for 2-3 minutes per side until lightly browned.
In a baking dish, spread half of the pesto on the bottom. Place the seared chicken breasts on top.
Layer roasted red peppers and fresh spinach over the chicken.
Spoon the remaining pesto over the top, then sprinkle with shredded mozzarella and Parmesan cheese.



Bake uncovered for 25-30 minutes or until the chicken reaches an internal temperature of 165°F.
Remove from the oven and place burrata on top. Let sit for 5 minutes to allow the burrata to soften slightly.
Garnish with fresh basil before serving.

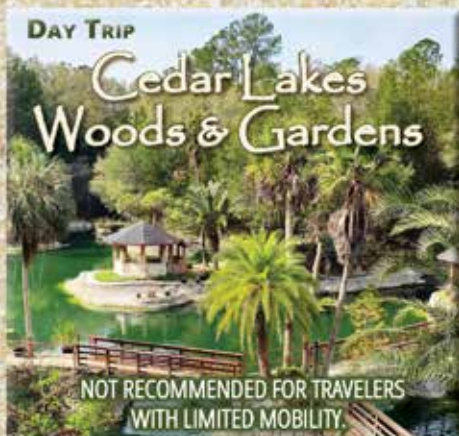

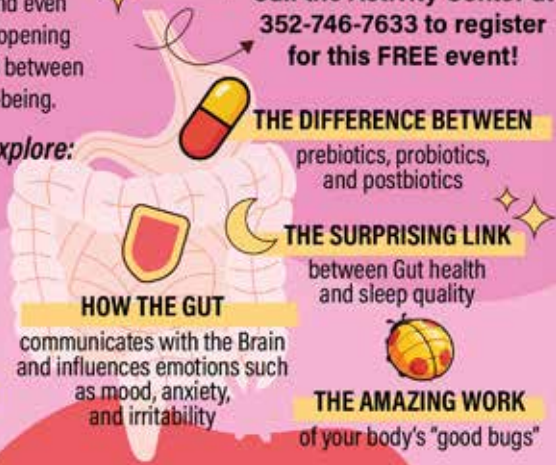

SCAM ALERT: BEWARE OF THIS DANGEROUS BANKING TEXT MESSAGE SCAM

Most people know to watch out for phishing emails, but scammers are now aggressively targeting victims through text messages as well. A dangerous banking-related text scam is circulating again, and many people are falling for it because it looks so convincing.

With more online shopping and increased bank activity, scammers are seizing the opportunity to trick users into revealing personal and financial information. Here's how the scam typically works:

1. They obtain your phone number—often from social media



or public profiles.

2. They research your name and location to determine which bank you likely use.

3. They send a fake text message claiming there's an urgent problem with your account, using your real bank's name to appear legitimate.

4. If you call the number in the text, the scammer pretends to be a

bank representative and asks you to "verify" your identity by providing personal and banking details.

Because the message references your actual bank, the scam feels credible—especially if you use a local institution. Unfortunately, this often leads to stolen information, emptied accounts, and major headaches for victims.

Bottom line:

If you receive a text that claims to be from your bank, do not reply or call the number in the message. Instead, contact your bank directly using the phone number on your bank statement or the bank's official website. Staying cautious is the best way to protect yourself.
