



## Golf Tips: Back to Basics: Mastering P.G.A. — Posture, Grip & Alignment

Great golf doesn't start with a perfect swing — it starts before the club ever moves. Whether you're a seasoned player or just getting back into rhythm, focusing on the fundamentals of P.G.A. — Posture, Grip, and Alignment can pay immediate dividends in consistency and confidence.

Posture is the foundation of every good swing. A balanced, athletic setup allows your body to move freely and repeatably. Stand with your feet shoulder-width apart, knees slightly flexed, and tilt forward from the hips — not the waist. Your back should be straight but relaxed, with your weight evenly distributed between the balls and heels of your feet. Good posture promotes solid contact and better balance throughout the swing.

Next comes the Grip, your only connection to the club.

A proper grip helps control the clubface and dictates ball flight. Hold the club in your fingers rather than the palm, maintaining light but secure pressure. Whether you prefer an overlapping, interlocking, or baseball-style grip, consistency is key. Check that both hands work together to allow the clubface to return square at impact.

Finally, Alignment ensures your swing is aimed at the right target. Too often, solid swings produce poor results simply due to misalignment. Set your clubface first, aiming it directly at your target, then align your feet, hips, and shoulders parallel to that line. Regularly practicing alignment can instantly improve accuracy without changing your swing.

By returning to P.G.A. basics, you'll build a more reliable swing — and enjoy better results every time you tee it up.



## Cozy Chicken Gnocchi Soup

### Ingredients

- 1/2 cup oil-packed sun-dried tomatoes
- 1 shallot, chopped
- 4 cloves garlic, chopped
- 2 tablespoons Italian seasoning
- 1 teaspoon smoked paprika
- Chili flakes (to taste)
- 3 tablespoons tomato paste
- 1 pound chicken breasts or thighs
- Salt and black pepper
- 4-6 cups chicken broth
- 4 ounces cream cheese, at room temperature
- 1 cup heavy cream or whole milk
- 2 cups chopped spinach
- 1/2 cup grated parmesan cheese
- 1 pound potato gnocchi
- Fresh basil or parsley, for serving

### Steps


1. Drain the oil from the sun-dried tomatoes - Take the jar of sun-dried tomatoes and drain a few tablespoons of the oil into your Dutch oven. I love using the oil from the jar—it's seasoned and works perfectly for Italian recipes.
2. Get cooking - To the oil, add the shallots, garlic, Italian seasoning, paprika, and chili flakes. Stir in the tomato paste and cook until it thickens slightly.
3. Now add the chicken and toss it with all those spices.
4. Add the broth and cook



the chicken. Pour in the broth and let the chicken cook for about 20 minutes. Once tender, shred the chicken directly into the soup.

5. Finish the soup. Mix in the cream cheese and milk until creamy. Add the spinach (or kale), the sun-dried tomatoes, and the gnocchi. Cook until the soup is hot and steamy and the gnocchi float to the top. Stir in some parmesan too!



### HOW TO SPOT AND AVOID CARD SKIMMING DEVICES

Card skimming scams are a growing threat at ATMs and gas pumps, allowing criminals to steal your card information and PIN—sometimes in seconds. These devices may be placed over the real card reader or hidden inside it, and are often paired with small cameras to capture your PIN as you type.

### Warning signs to watch for:

- A card reader that looks loose, bulky, misaligned, or different from others nearby
- Resistance when inserting your card or a reader that wiggles when touched
- Unfamiliar Bluetooth devices appearing on your phone while near an ATM or gas pump
- A tap to pay reader that isn't lit up.

### How to protect yourself:

Always inspect the card reader before use and avoid machines that look tampered with. If anything

seems suspicious, leave and use another ATM or gas station. When entering your PIN, cover the keypad with your hand to block hidden cameras. Regularly review your bank statements and enable text or email alerts for transactions so you can catch fraud immediately. If you believe your card information has been compromised, contact your bank right away to cancel the card and report the fraud. Acting quickly can significantly reduce—or even eliminate—your financial loss. Staying alert and informed is your best defense against card skimming scams.
