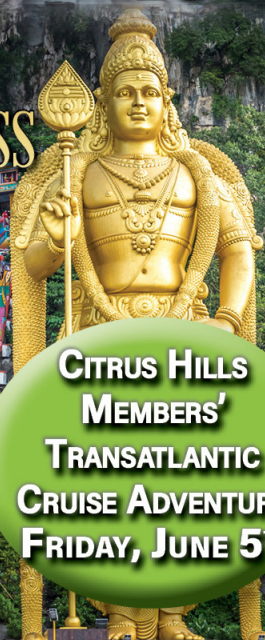

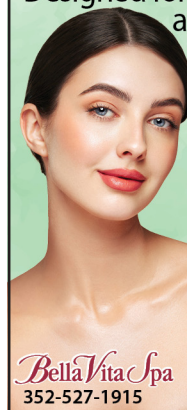

Golf Tips:

Controlling distance is one of the most important aspects of successful putting. While reading greens and aiming your putter are key components, the ability to control how far the ball rolls is what separates consistent putters from the rest. Good distance control helps eliminate three-putts and leaves you with more makeable second putts—even when your read isn't perfect.

A great way to improve your distance control is by practicing the "In-Between Drill," which emphasizes feel over mechanics. Start about 10 feet from the hole. Your first goal is to hit a putt that finishes a few feet short of the hole—intentionally under-hitting it. On your second putt, aim to roll the ball a few feet past the hole. Now, the challenge: roll a third putt that stops somewhere in between

the first two. This "in-between" target trains your touch and helps you understand how subtle changes in stroke length and tempo affect distance. The key to this drill is consistency. Focus on maintaining the same tempo with each stroke, adjusting only the length of your backswing to change the distance. Repeat the drill from different spots on the green, including uphill, downhill, and sidehill lies, to better simulate on-course conditions.

Practicing this regularly will sharpen your feel and make you more adaptable on the greens. With improved distance control, you'll leave yourself more makeable second putts and avoid those frustrating three-putts that can derail a good round. And who knows—some of those perfectly paced putts might even find the bottom of the cup!

3. Customized Loft and Bounce: Wedges come with various lofts and bounce angles, and getting a fitting allows you to choose the ones that best suit your swing and playing conditions. This is especially useful for players who struggle with bunker shots, flop shots, or chipping around the greens.

4. Consistency in Your Short Game: A wedge fitting session helps to eliminate the guesswork in your short game. When you're using a wedge that is optimized for your game, you'll find that your shots are more predictable, making it easier to execute various types of shots, from chips to delicate bunker shots.

Neighborhood News

As many of you have probably already noticed, there have been some changes throughout the communities, particularly with irrigation schedules and the operation of our fountains. I wanted to take a moment to explain what's driving those changes and what you can expect over the next few months.

Citrus County has now been placed under Modified Phase III Water Shortage restrictions, effective April 3rd through July 1st. In practical terms, this means water use is being more tightly controlled across the board due to ongoing dry conditions and strain on our water supply. These are not Citrus Hills' decisions or restrictions, but district-wide requirements imposed by the Southwest Florida Water Management District that apply to residents, businesses, and associations alike.

From a home-owner's perspective, the most noticeable impacts will be reduced irrigation windows and adjustments to watering schedules. Many of you will see changes in when irrigation

systems are running, and in some cases, less frequent watering overall. These changes are necessary to comply with the new restrictions and to avoid enforcement actions.

You will also likely notice that our community fountains are not operating as often as they typically do. Under the current restrictions, aesthetic fountains are limited to a set number of hours per day, so their operation has been reduced accordingly. While we understand this affects the look and feel of certain areas, it is a required conservation measure during this period.

It's also worth noting that associations are not permitted to require increased water use for aesthetic purposes, so landscaping expectations may be temporarily adjusted as well. Please let me know if you have additional questions at moses@citrushills.com.



Rosemary Salmon and Veggies

Ingredients

1-1/2 pounds salmon fillets, cut into 4 portions
2 tablespoons melted coconut oil or olive oil
2 tablespoons balsamic vinegar
2 teaspoons minced fresh rosemary or 3/4 teaspoon dried rosemary, crushed
1 garlic clove, minced
1/2 teaspoon salt
1 pound fresh asparagus, trimmed
1 medium sweet red pepper, cut into 1-inch pieces
1/4 teaspoon pepper
Lemon wedges

Directions

1. Preheat oven to 400°. Place salmon in a greased 15x10x1-in. baking pan. Combine oil, vinegar, rosemary, garlic, and salt. Pour half over the salmon. Place asparagus and red pepper in a large bowl; drizzle with remaining oil mixture and toss to coat. Arrange around salmon in the pan; sprinkle with pepper.
2. Bake until salmon flakes easily with a fork and vegetables are tender, 12-15 minutes. Serve with lemon wedges.



3. Variations: Serve it over a bed of herbed rice pilaf for a fantastic addition to this meal. Try mixing a tablespoon or two of pure maple syrup in with the vinegar. Or even a sprinkle or two of crushed red pepper would add just enough spice to the salmon without overpowering the other flavors.

HOW TO CHOOSE 'UNGUSSABLE' ANSWERS TO SECURITY QUESTIONS

Have you ever clicked "Forgot password?" and been asked to answer a security question? These questions are designed to confirm your identity and protect your account—but if used incorrectly, they can actually make you more vulnerable to hackers.

Common questions like "What is your mother's maiden name?" or "What was your first school?" may seem secure, but the answers are often easy to find. Friends, family,



or even strangers can sometimes discover this information through casual conversations or simple online searches.

Because of this, security questions can be surprisingly weak if you answer them truthfully. A smarter approach is to treat them like an extra password.

Instead of providing real answers, choose something unrelated and difficult to guess—such as a random phrase or combination of words.

For example, answering "LittleRedDrummerBoy" to a personal question makes it nearly impossible for others to figure out. Using the same consistent (but unrelated) answer across accounts can also make it easier to remember.

Taking this simple step can significantly strengthen your account security.

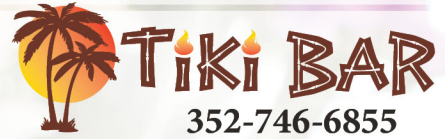

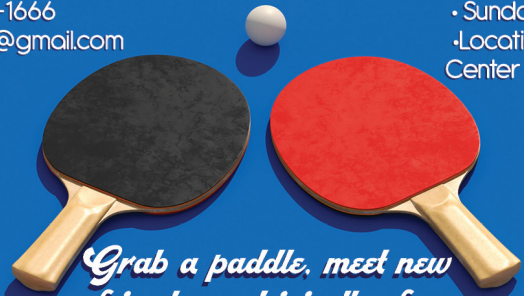
