We were pleased to welcome 262 attendees and provide an overview of current initiatives before opening the floor for approximately 90 minutes of questions and discussion.

Within the next two weeks, we will also be posting a summary on the Club website that includes many of the questions asked, along with follow-up answers and key information that was presented during the meeting. One of the most frequently asked questions regarding the SportsPlex involved parking availability. to amenities located in that section of the complex. While both projects remain under construction, we will continue to keep everyone informed as soon as definitive completion timelines become available.

We have placed significant emphasis on enhancing both our food quality and service standards, and we have received many positive comments from members who have noticed the improvements. 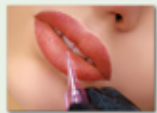

Golf Tips:

Conquering Florida's Summer Rough

Summertime golf in Florida brings one of the game's toughest challenges—thick bermudagrass rough. During the warmer months, Bermuda grows aggressively, creating dense, wiry lies that make clean contact difficult and shot outcomes less predictable.

One of the biggest challenges is how the grass affects the clubhead through impact. As thick Bermuda wraps around the hosel, it can pull the clubface closed, effectively turning it down and reducing loft. The result is often a shot that flies lower and shorter than expected, with a tendency to go left for right-handed golfers. The deeper the ball sits, the more pronounced this effect becomes.

Proper club selection is critical. Choosing a club with more loft can help offset the loss of loft caused by the rough. Short irons and wedges are usually safer choices, while long irons and fairway woods can be difficult to control. If the ball is deeply buried, focus on simply advancing it back into play.

Position the ball slightly back in your stance and make a controlled, descending swing. Avoid trying to overpower the shot, as swinging harder often increases the rough's influence on the clubhead.

Most importantly, manage your expectations. Sometimes the smartest play is a simple pitch back to the fairway with a high lofted. Understanding how bermudagrass affects the clubface and making disciplined decisions can save valuable strokes during Florida's summer golf season.

Neighborhood News

By Cyle Moses, General Counsel

As many residents are aware, Citrus County remains subject to the Southwest Florida Water Management District's Modified Phase III Water Shortage Order. The current order is scheduled to expire on July 1, 2026.

As of the date of drafting this newsletter, SWFWMD has not announced an extension, modification, or replacement of the current order. While no one can predict the district's final decision, several outcomes are possible. SWFWMD could allow the order to expire and return to normal year-round watering restrictions, reduce restrictions by moving to a less severe shortage phase (phase 1, phase 2, etc.), extend the current Phase III order, or adopt a different water shortage order based on current conditions and available data (phase 4, etc.).

With the summer rainy season underway, the district will continue monitoring rainfall totals, aquifer levels, lake levels, and overall water supply conditions before determining whether any additional restrictions will be

necessary after July 1st. Until any changes are officially announced, residents should continue following the

current watering requirements.
