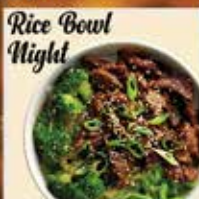

Neighborhood News

As many residents have likely noticed, work continues at the intersection of County Road 486 and Ottawa Avenue. This project involves the construction of a new golf cart crossing, which is now nearing completion.

The crossing will provide a safer way for golf carts to travel between Davis Reserve/Brentwood and Terra Vista. As the project is finalized, we will publish separate information explaining how the crossing is to be used, along with any applicable traffic rules.

As our communities continue to grow, we would also like to remind everyone to remain mindful while traveling throughout our neighborhoods. More homes are being completed, more families are moving in, and more pedestrians, bicyclists, and golf carts are using our roadways each day. Please slow down, obey posted speed limits, and drive

attentively.

We also ask that residents keep their dogs on a leash whenever they are outside the home. We understand that many pets are beloved members of the family, but leashes help protect your pet, your neighbors, and others who may be walking, cycling, or enjoying the community amenities.

Finally, the Southwest Florida Water Management District's Modified Phase III Water Shortage Order has been extended through October 1st. Until the District announces any changes, all residents should continue following the current watering restrictions. We will continue to monitor updates from SWFWMD and keep everyone informed if the order is modified or lifted.



Apple Cider Glazed Chicken Thighs

Prep time 5 minutes | Cook
time 35 minutes | Serves 4

Ingredients

- 2 cloves garlic
- 1 cup apple cider or unfiltered apple juice
- 1 (2-inch) fresh rosemary sprig
- ¼ teaspoon Dijon mustard
- 2 pounds bone-in, skin-on chicken thighs (4 to 6)
- ½ teaspoon kosher salt
- ¼ teaspoon freshly ground black pepper
- 2 teaspoons vegetable oil
- 2 tablespoons unsalted butter

Directions

Arrange a rack in the middle of the oven and heat the oven to 350°F.

Smash 2 garlic cloves and place in a small saucepan. Add 1 cup apple cider, 1 fresh rosemary sprig, and ¼ teaspoon Dijon mustard. Stir and bring to a boil, uncovered, over medium-high heat. Boil until reduced to ¼ cup, 15 to 20 minutes. Meanwhile, start cooking the chicken.

Pat 2 pounds chicken thighs dry with paper towels, then season with ½ teaspoon kosher salt and ¼ teaspoon black pepper.

Heat 2 teaspoons vegetable oil in a large frying pan or cast-

iron skillet over medium-high heat until it shimmers. Place the chicken skin-side down, and cook undisturbed until the skin is browned and the chicken releases easily from the pan, adjusting the heat if the skin begins to burn, 8 to 10 minutes.

When the glaze is ready, whisk in 2 tablespoons unsalted butter until melted, then remove from the heat. When the chicken is ready, transfer it to a plate. Carefully pour off all but 1 tablespoon of the fat in the pan. Return the chicken to the pan skin-side up, and spoon the glaze evenly over it.

Transfer the pan to the oven



and bake for 5 minutes. Spoon some of the glaze in the pan back over the chicken, then continue baking until the chicken reaches an internal temperature of 165°F, 5 to 7 minutes more. Turn the oven on to broil, and broil until the skin is dark golden brown and the sauce is bubbling, 1 to 2 minutes.

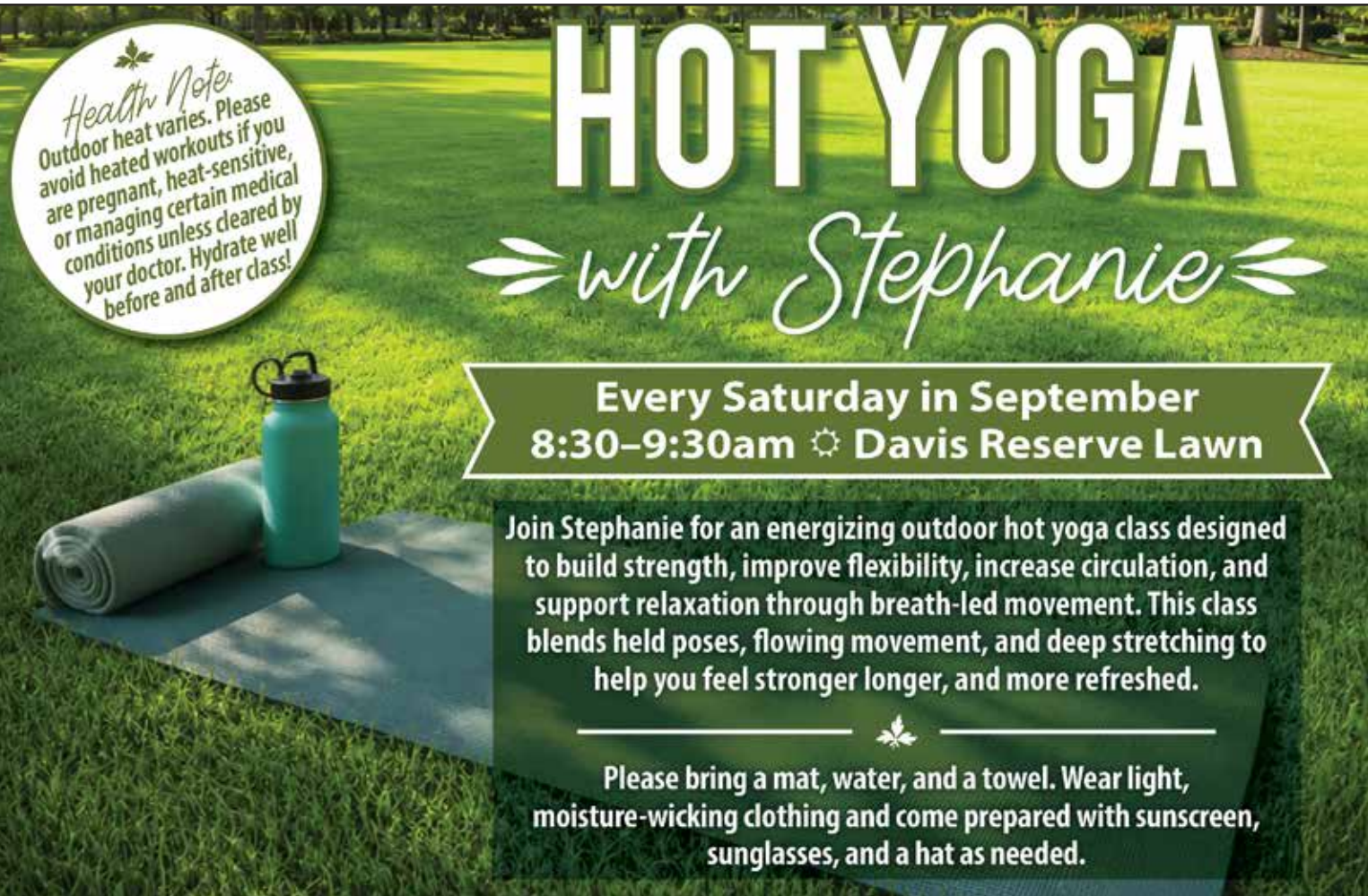
